Special Purpose Vessel "Miss Emma McCall" IMO No 9289659 Class No.03116759 ,Gross Tonnage 493, on 14 July 2020 and subsequent dates, at the Freeport Launch Services in order to examine and report on the equipment and arrangements on board the vessel with reference to MARPOL Annex V(garbage pollution prevention).

The Vessel is fitted with the following equipment and arrangements:

Type of Garbage as per Reg 1(1) of Annex V and Section 1.7 of the Guidelines:

- The types of garbage normally produced are as follows:

- Plastics
- Food wastes
- Domestic wastes
- Cooking oil

Placards: as per Reg 9(1) of Annex V and 4.4 of the Guidelines:

- Placards are posted in a conspicuous place in the galley and at garbage storage receptacles in the mess room, navigation bridge,lounge room on first(01) deck and engine room.

Garbage Management Plan & Garbage Record Book: as per Reg 9(2) & 9(3) of Annex V and Section 2.3.4 of the Guidelines:

- Garbage Management Plan developed by the owner providing written procedures for collecting,storing, processing and disposal of garbage including the use of the equipment was provided on board. The document is written in a language understood by the crew.
- The Garbage Record Book was provided on board.

Garbage Collection and Storage: as per Section 2.4 & 2.6 of the Guidelines:

- Garbage containers are provided in the galley/mess room/pantry room areas,lounge room area in addition to accommodation areas, navigation bridge deck and the engine control room.
